IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

Due to new weight restrictions from our flight carrier, we have an important update regarding the weight policy for your upcoming trip. These changes are in place to ensure everyone's safety and to comply with the new regulations.

New Weight Policy

The new standard allowance is **240 lbs total per person**, which includes body weight plus all luggage. Please note the following specifics:

- Luggage Limit: Your luggage, including carry-on and backpacks, is now limited to a maximum of 40 lbs.
- Any luggage exceeding the 40 lbs limit must be left at the hotel.
- **Total Plane Weight:** The total weight restriction for the Cessna Caravan aircraft is now **2,500 lbs** for the entire group. If the total weight exceeds this limit, we may need to charter an additional smaller plane, a Cessna 206, to accommodate the excess.
- Overweight Charges: Any personal weight over the 240 lbs per person allowance will incur a charge of \$8 per additional pound, payable in cash to our partners in Guyana before departure to the jungle.

Travel Light to Avoid Issues

To help us stay within these new limits and avoid extra fees, please pack as lightly as possible. Here are some suggestions:

- Leave unnecessary items like heavy bags, travel clothes and heavy footwear, and any extra gear at the hotel.
- We highly recommend that partners share tackle and gear to minimize weight.
- Consider bringing one box of lures instead of two.
- Use travel rods to avoid heavy rod tubes.
- ONLY bring soft-sided bags instead of rigid suitcases. Hard cases will not be allowed on the plane.
- Please **do not bring any sinkers or weights** with you; you can purchase them at the lodge.
